Expenses which may be covered under the FUND include, but are not limited to:

Mammograms and Radiologists
Breast Ultrasound

Interpretation Fees
Prostheses & Bras

Prosthetic Wigs
Special Services

It is the intent of the Breast Cancer Endowment Fund that any qualified women in our service area may receive a grant to pay for or help with expenses for prostheses, bras, wigs, and mammograms.

Mammograms, counseling and other medical services must be provided by the following to qualify for a grant:

Patients who have limited or no income, and those who do not have health care coverage may qualify for a Grant under "Financial Need."

The term "Special Needs" refers to a situation where the patient does not fall within our financial guidelines but extenuating circumstances result in her inability to pay for needed services.

Grants are made without discrimination against any person because of race, color, national and ethnic origin or handicap condition.

If other resources are available to cover part of the cost for services, the Fund may approve a grant to cover the balance for qualified patients.
